From the training which took place in Stockholm, Sweden between 14.10.2019-18.10.2019, participants of our university (UTECA) including Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs and Director of Quality Assurance Department learned that what is CDIO and how to make sure that all programs are compliance with these CDIO Standards. Additionally, the importance of sustainable development and its integration to the learning outcomes of study programs was thought during conference. Different experiences from various countries such as China, Japan, Argentina and Chile were shared, and quality assurance and knowledge assessment system of KTH were presented from different aspects.
