<p>- How did you introduce a quality assurance system?</p>	<p>The Quality Assurance Center has been launched on July 1, 2018 by the order of the Rector. The Center doesn't operate independently. It is functioning within the International Relations Department. However, The Center is expected to function as an independent unit in the future.</p>
<p>- What is the place of a Quality Assurance Center within an organizational structure?</p>	<p>"Quality Assurance Center" is a section functioning within the Department of International Relations. The Center regulates the organization of the educational process of the university, the implementation of quality policy, as well as the process of career planning and internships of graduates, and is under the curatorship of the Rector.</p> <p>However, the functioning of the unit as an independent department is planned for the near future. The Center is functioning with the departments, Career Center, chairs and other sectors in the university and presents the relevant reports to the Rector. The Center is established and abolished by the order of Rector.</p>
<p>- What is the main role of the Quality Assurance Center at your university?</p>	<p>The role of QA unit in the process of quality assurance at the university is reflected in the existing regulations. The main areas of activity of QA Unit include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Develop appropriate plan for strategic plan for development and management efficiency in the monitoring, evaluation and prognosticate to improve the quality of education.</li> <li>2. monitoring the quality of education at the university</li> <li>3. data collection, preparation of analytical information to ensure optimal management decisions, organizational, methodological.</li> </ol>

- Did you launch the Quality Assurance Center within the EQAC project?	Yes, The QAC at ACU has been launched within the EQAC project.

In order to support The Internal Quality Assurance processes for the training programs, the structure was reorganized perfectly during the updating of the training programs in the "pilot speciality" within the EQAC project. All in all proposals regarding approval of programmes are periodically discussed and decisions are made in the Faculty Scientific Councils with the participation of all stakeholders.

During the preparation of programs in specialities, a program group is created at ACU, including Education Department, program teachers, Career Center, QAC,faculties and other stakeholders.( pilot program)

- Does your institution have in place a procedure for student appeals/complaints in place?	The Appeal Commission is created each term. Students' complaints are reviewed by this Commission.

- What is your role in quality assurance as a faculty dean/chair?	QAC always creates a relation with faculty, dean. Because it's one of the main structural units. We always conduct surveys, collect them, discuss together, share our opinion.

- How does your institution ensure that the teaching staff is qualified and competent?	In 2019 ACU conducted a great survey among the students and awarded the best teachers of the year. In 2018 ACU organized monitoring among teachers to ensure language skills of them.
